Dalhousie University and the Department of Urology are accepting applications for the Kidney Transplantation and advanced MIS/robotics Fellowship.

Fellowship is accredited by ASTS and pending Royal College accreditation for dual designation.

Participate in all aspects of kidney transplantation including live donor nephrectomy, deceased donor organ procurements, kidney transplant procedures, dialysis access surgery (AV fistulas and PD catheter insertions) and management of transplant complications.

Additional opportunities to participate in advanced laparoscopic and robotic renal surgery including laparoscopic/open radical nephrectomies, robotic partial nephrectomy, robotic pyeloplasty and open pelvic surgery. Lastly, fellows will have the opportunity to participate in PCNL with own access.

Both one and two year options are available. Research opportunities are available but not mandatory.
