Opportunity for Endourologist in Thunder Bay, Ontario, Canada

Position Description:

The Department of Surgery is seeking a full-time endourologist to become a part of the team at the Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre (TBRHSC) located in Thunder Bay, Ontario. The successful surgeon will join an established group of six urologists at TBRHSC and can anticipate to start by May 1, 2025.

Specific Skills:

The ideal candidate should possess postgraduate training and experience in advanced endourology. A strong background in percutaneous renal surgery and minimally invasive endourological techniques is essential. The physician will be responsible for providing urology services at TBRHSC, as well as at three regional hospitals (approximately one visit per month), and will also participate in the urology on-call schedule at TBRHSC. Candidates who have a keen interest in clinical program development, teaching residents and medical students, and engaging in research are particularly encouraged to apply. Experience in endourology research and surgical simulation is highly valued.

Remuneration:

Compensation for this position will be based on clinical billings (fee-for-service). Eligibility for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario is required.

Serving Northwestern Ontario

Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre provides healthcare services to Northwestern Ontario, extending from east of White River to the Manitoba border in the west, and from Hudson Bay in the north to the United States border in the south.
