Program Overview:

A one-year postgraduate University of Toronto accredited fellowship program providing specialized training in minimally invasive urologic surgery. Eligible applicants must have completed a Canadian urologic residency and be able to obtain certification in the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons (FRCSC).

The program offers hands-on clinical experience with advanced endoscopic surgery for benign prostatic hyperplasia (Greenlight Photovaporization of the Prostate), stone disease (percutaneous renal access, ureteroscopy), urologic oncology, laparoscopic, microsurgical and reconstructive surgery.
