Information on Ordering PET Scans for Urology and Genitourinary Surgery in Ontario

Ontario continues to approve new indications for PET scan use including recent approval of PSMA-PET that makes this vital test easier to order. Below is a brief overview of the streamlined ordering process, to help urologists and genitourinary surgeons put PET scans to work for their patients.



How do I order a PET scan?

- 1. Register via CCO's online referral tool
- 2. Once registered, login to download the appropriate requisition form and submit your request. Some indications will require supporting documentation.
- 3. Send your request to the **location** of your choice.

Which cases can I order a PET scan for?

PET scans are **pre-approved for OHIP funding** for the following Genitourinary Cancers:
